- Pus\_reflected = ReflectionFunction( P\_mirror, Pus\_via\_Mirror)
- Pus\_reflected~=Pus

# **Visualization - Iterative Closest Point (ICP)**

- Minimize the difference between two point Cloud for each pose
- Average all ICP matrices to get one transformation



### Results

• % error analysis for translation vector

Normal Alignment without ICP: %x = 1.4799 %y = 1.475 %z = 0.2

With ICP: %x = 1.38 %y = 0.8 %z = 0.2

% of Improvements using ICP x = 6.7% y = 45% z=0%



# Conclusion

Why Use mirror over another OTS?

- Very High Accuracy
- Very Cheap
- Flexible movements & easy to setup
- Can be sterilized
