- Focal length (corrective glasses)

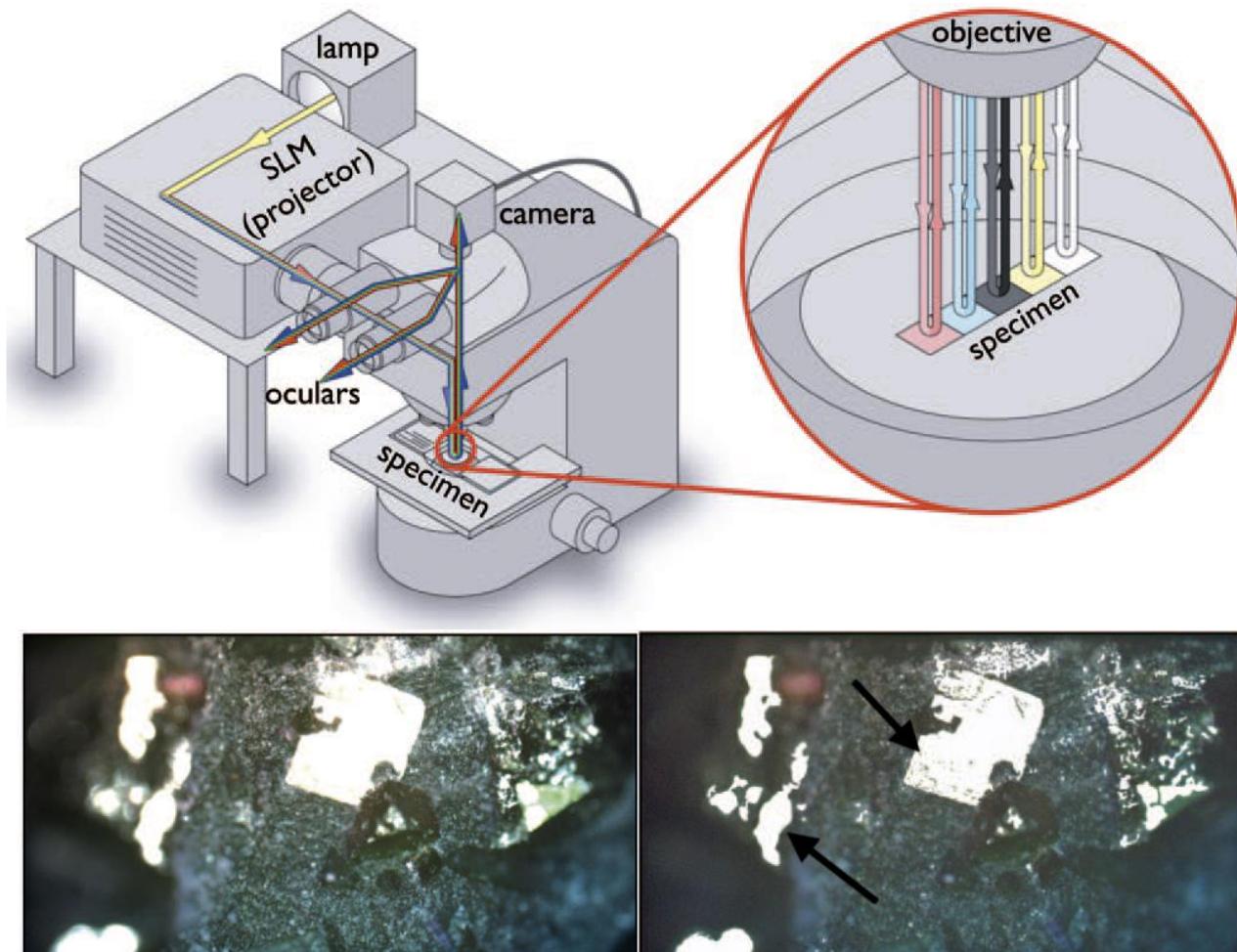

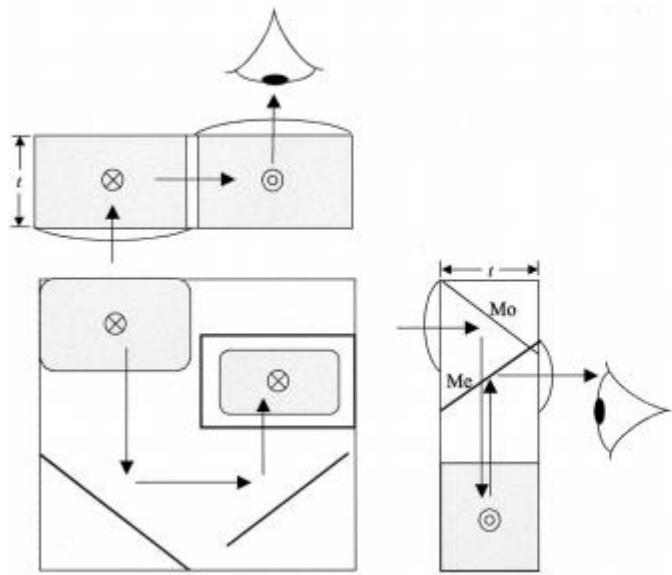


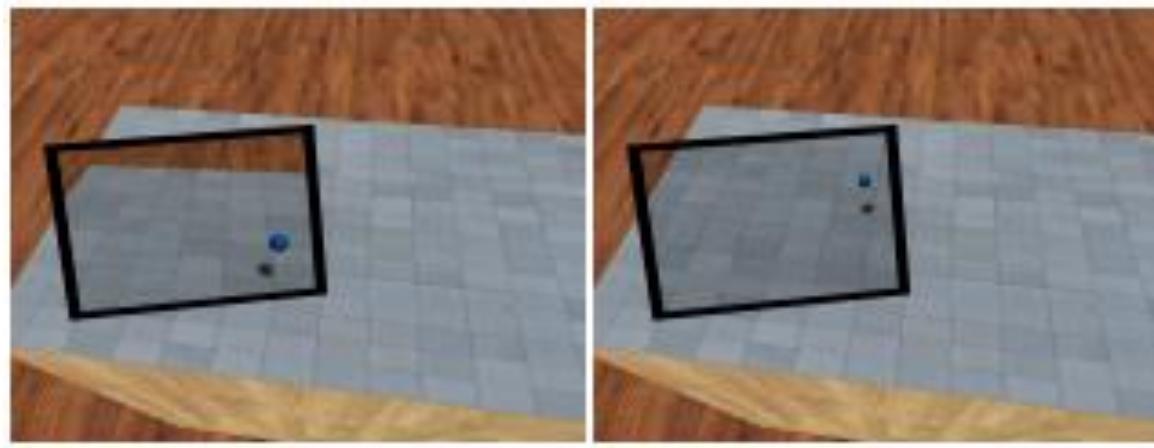

An illustration of the view of the SimulVision effect that is possible with



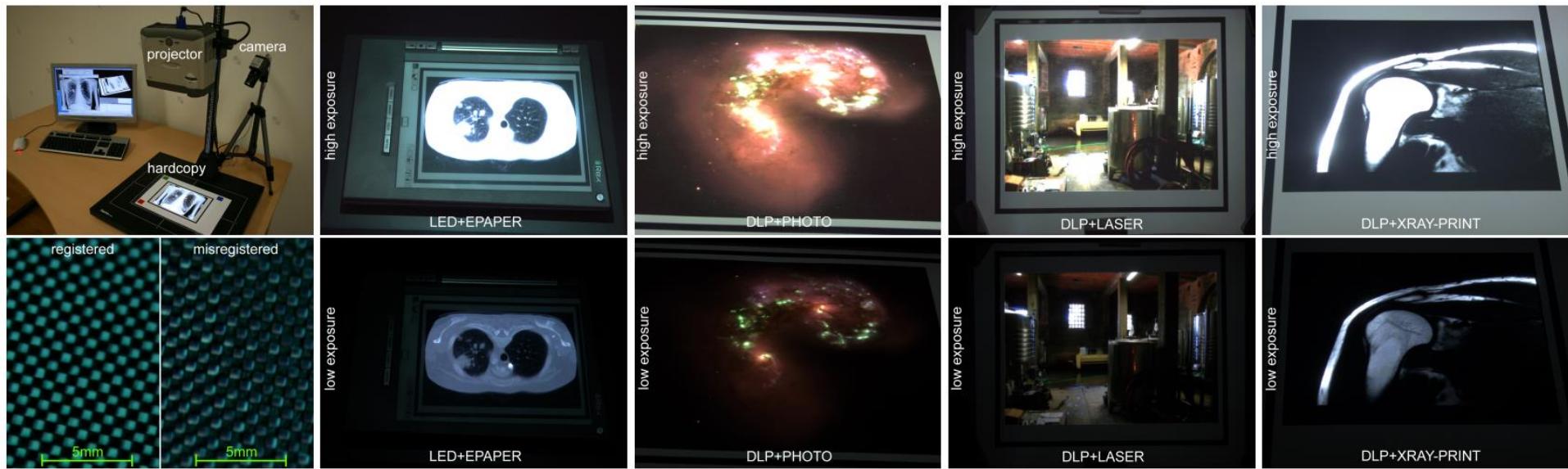

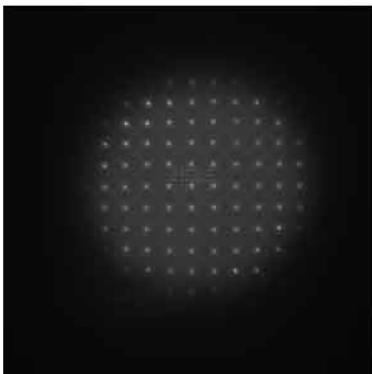
Zernike Polynomial



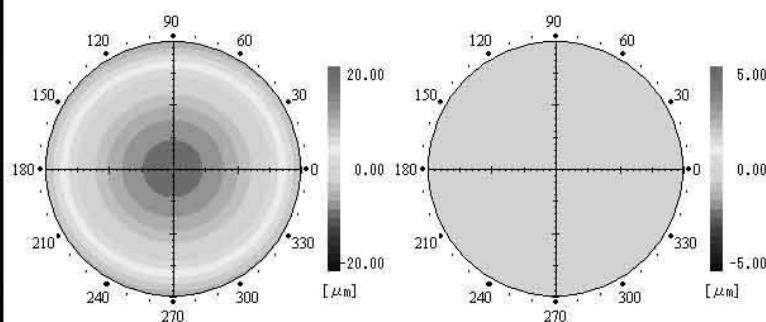
