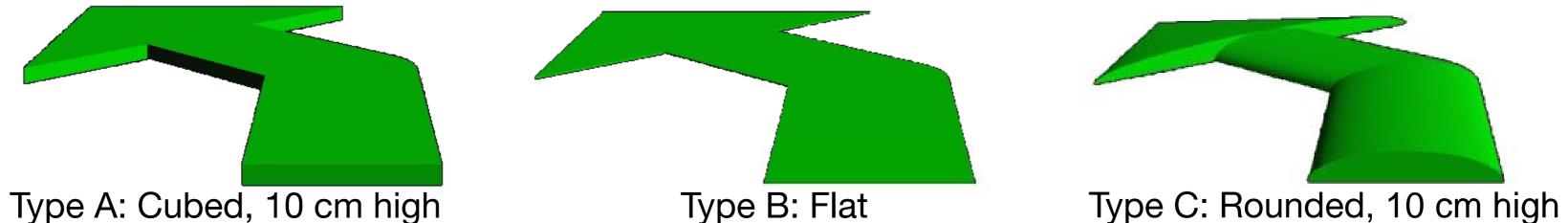
## Perception Thresholds for Augmented Reality Navigation Schemes at Large Distances

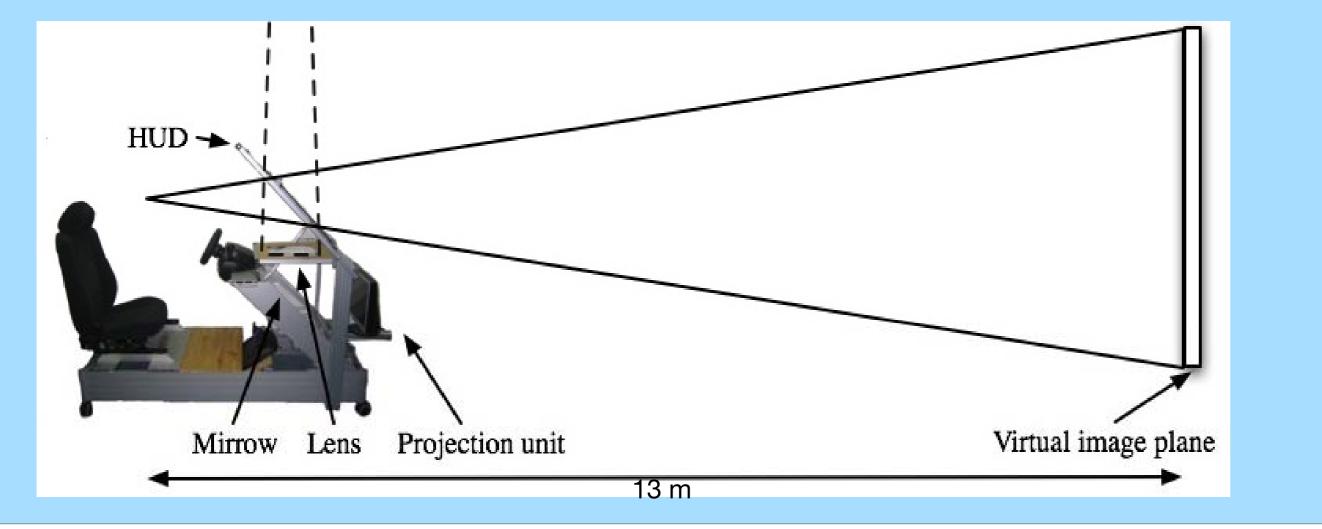

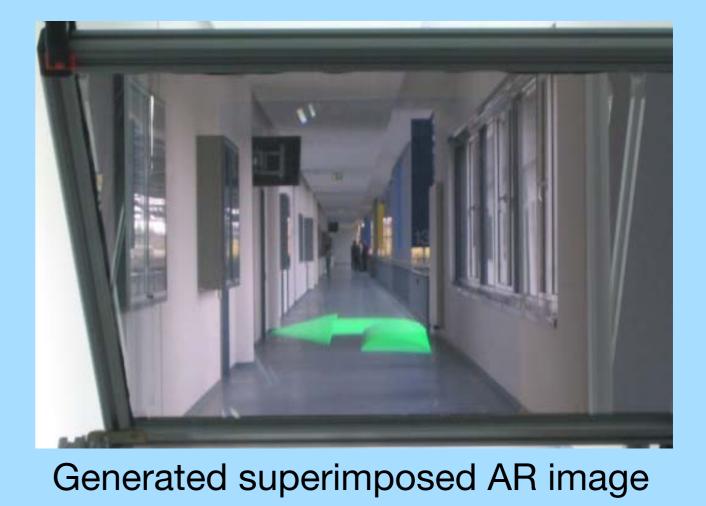
**Issue:** Resolution of AR displays is lower than the resolution of the human eye. AR Schemes get pixelized at large distances **Approach:** Determine effects of presentation scheme design on their perceptibility in a Head-Up Display (HUD)



## HUD:

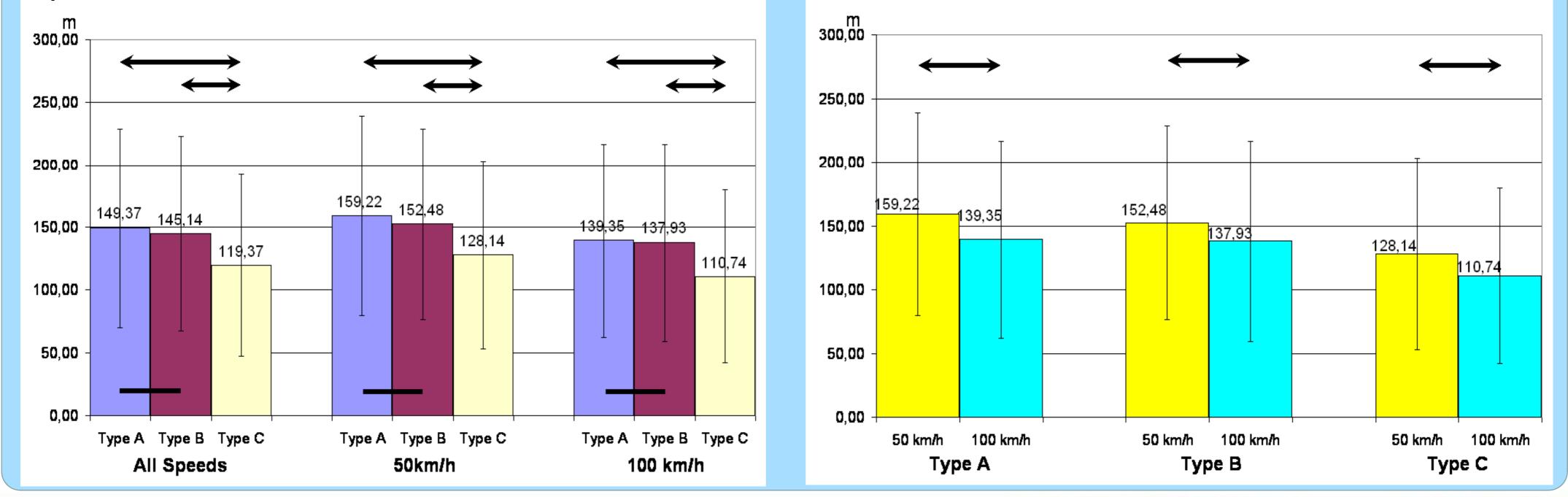
- Display with resolution of 1680x1050 pixels
- Lens generating field of view of 34 degrees. Pixels have relative size of about 3.5 cm in 100m distance.
- Lens moves focal plane to distance of 13 m.





## **Study & Results:**

- •16 test subjects (mean age 25.5, standard deviation 2.94)
- Arrows appeared in long hallway at large distance and moved towards test subject
- As soon as the sign could be read, the test subject pressed button and indicated the perceived direction
